HEIDE I – THE NEXT PHASE

Heide I, the Victorian farmhouse purchased by John and Sunday Reed in 1934, will be temporarily closed for maintenance works from December 2006.

The repairs to this historic exhibition space at Heide Museum of Modern Art are required as a result of the unseasonably dry weather throughout 2005 and 2006 and the high volume of visitors to Heide I during the Museum's 2005-06 Redevelopment Program.

A full review of the work required and the length of the closure of Heide I will be ascertained in 2007.

Visitors will still be able to view this important building from January 2007 via in-depth Heide I architecture and history tours conducted on the final Saturday of each month.
