Professional Development for teachers

Behind the mask: exploring identity through the Kelly paintings of Sidney Nolan

Teachers are invited to participate in a Community of Inquiry discussion, facilitated by Sharon Leibowitz. The session focuses on the later paintings of Ned Kelly by Sidney Nolan and the artist's use of the Kelly mask as metaphor for personal identity.

The Community of Inquiry process allows teachers to collectively discuss and investigate artworks through the modelling of useful classroom techniques. The session demonstrates what the Community of Inquiry is, how works of art can be used as a stimulus for discussions, how it can assist to introduce thinking curriculum into the classroom, and how it can be used as a stimulus for group inquiry.
